I am very happy to inform you that after years of hard work, Lions Club International have granted the fund for the purchase of the Machineries for the Vocational training center for the disabled. I thank heartily to Lion Jayantibhai Patel, Lion Jayeshbhai Dalal and Lion Arunaben Oswal for their kind efforts for this sanction. We are sure that after completion of this vocational training the persons with disabilities shall start earning thus and they will live a life with respect and dignity

I do not have enough words to thank all our patrons and donors for their support, generous donation and kind cooperation extended to us in the past. I am sure you all shall continue to bestow your blessings upon this institution year after year.

In the coming year we need to construct a building for the Vocational Training Center cum Production workshop for persons with disabilities. I earnestly, request all of you to extend your wholehearted support and co-operation for raising this center.

The lives of Children with special needs are undergoing remarkable changes with the efforts of Blind welfare council.

Jyotsana's Journey towards Independent living

You are aware that, at BWC Dahod one of our programs is imparting primary education to the children with special needs. At the same time as per their ability we are also imparting vocational training to such children and adults so that they can live a social and economical independent life. Let us know about the journey of Jyotsana – From dependent living childhood to independent living adulthood.

Jyotsana Nisarta is from an Adivasi – farmer family living in backward village- Kadvaal of Jhalod taluka; District Dahod

At the age of just 2 years she was infected by Polio. The mother also being disabled herself could understand this critical situation. She tried her level best to reduce the disability. She did almost everything in medicine. However she could not prevent her from a disability of about 40 %.

Jyotsana was good in studies and she used to stand first in her class during her school days. In Std 10th she secured 63 % and in Std 12th she secured 73 %. She joined PTC (primary teachers training

course) and was successful with 80 % marks. But by just 1% she could not be selected for the post of a teacher as our system is purely merit based. She was disappointed but was positive. She tried for some other profession. She had a good network and could get connected with one of our teachers and she came to know about the Computer training course conducted by Blind welfare council. This course is specially for the persons with disabilities and is approved by GCVT (Gujarat council of Vocational training). She joined this course and started learning to operate computer and within one year she could complete the course of Computer operator. Immediately she got a job in Shivam computers Limdi as a computer teacher. Her first earning was Rs 2500/- per month. She was very happy. She did this job for one year and then she was lucky to get a Government job in the Project called "Chief Minister's Amrutam Maa Yojana" as a Taluka Kiosk. Her payment went up to Rs 4500/- per month. The beneficiaries covered under this project were people from BPL (Below poverty line) as well as APL (Above poverty Line). In this project She used to take a web photo of the beneficiary, take a thumb impression, and enter all the needed data in the computer. Finally she used to get a print out of Identity card and hand it to the beneficiary. The total procedure in this project is done successfully by Jyotsana independently. She is in this job from last 2years and 7 months. From her earning she is not only able to bear her own living expenses but she is also helping her family. The family members are very happy. The society members respect Jyotsana as she is a Government employee now rather an earning member of the family and the society. It's also a matter of pride for Blind welfare council Dahod.

Programmes / Activities of the Organisation

Lalit Bahuviklang Paathshaala and Day care center (For the children with mental retardation and multiple disabilities)

The Multiple disabled residential school run by BWC Dahod is first of its kind in Gujarat. At present there <u>are 72 children</u> with multiple disabilities out of <u>which 51 are boys and 21 are girls</u>. They stay in the hostel and get systematic training and education. The development is slow but constant. The number of teachers provided by the Government is few, but the Trust has appointed adequate number of teachers at its own cost and is trying to provide best services to the children.

We also have Day care center for children with mental retardation and multiple disabilities. Here in we have <u>30 boys and 17 girls with the total of 47</u> such children who are imparted training and education during the day. The children go back to home in the evening. Our teachers work very hard for the all round development of these children. We also have trained teachers who work in the villages as well. These teachers cover almost all the Talukas of Dahod and the Panchmahal districts.

Residential School for the children with Hearing Impairment (Std 1-5)

Since last 5 years we are conducting a primary educational training with residential set up for the children with hearing impairment. Here we had <u>admitted 18 children</u> with hearing impairment in the age group of 6 – 14 years. We trained them for their activities of daily living, academics, extracurricular activities, sports, drama dance, singing and other cultural activities etc. We are also giving training with group hearing aid, sign language, lip reading etc. This year we have <u>24 such</u> students in this special school. All these students are provided education, lodging and boarding free of cost.

IEDSS (Inclusive Education for Disabled Children at Secondary Stage)

We are running this program with the help of the government of India and the IEDSS cell based at GCERT Gandhinagar. Here we cover disabled children with different categories from Std 9th – 12th. These children study in the normal schools of their own villages. Our special teachers who are trained in that particular category teach these children and provide all the special training needed as per the disability of the student. They also help them to get all kinds of Government and Non Government benefits. In this program our special teachers cover the following children with disabilities.

The above numbers of children are registered with us and we provide all government benefits to them. Under this program approx 1000 children are being provided educational kits and one pair of school uniform Additional tools is also provided depending on the needs of the children like: Tricycle, Crutches, Hearing aid, Tape Recorders, Wheel chair.

Human Resource Development

The Institute has always tried to give teaching and training to persons who can train the disabled ones. Under such plans the Institute has started the work of Man Power Development.

Moreover, the trust also trains teachers of normal schools. They join in the Foundation course for the persons with disability. It is a 90 days course recognized by Rehabilitation Council of India, New Delhi. The Trust also organizes Refresher Courses - C.R.E program for the special teachers who have been registered in the disabled areas by the R.C.I. New Delhi.

Industrial Training Center & Vocational training center:

With a mission of training the persons with disabilities and to enable them to earn a livelihood with respect and dignity, the institute is running Industrial training center (ITC) from last 7 years, Here a Computer operator course is being conducted, 20 beneficiaries are taking training in this course.

Under the vocational training center we are training about 15 children in making paper dish, candles, chalks, door mates, to manufacture decorative items, glass painting, greeting card, gifts etc.

Early Intervention Programme

Under this program round the year surveys are being conducted to identify disabled children from 0 – 4 years. An assessment of abilities and disabilities of these children is made and accordingly early intervention plans and counseling program are framed and implemented.

Lions Vocational training Center:

On the occasion of Louis Braille birth anniversary

Lion Aruna Oswal Chief Endorsee of Lions club International and Dist Governor Lion P B Bariya Inaugurated the Lions Vocational training center for the disabled. All the appliances and machineries of this vocational training center are purchased from the Grants of Lions Club International Fund. The trades to be started in this vocational training for the disabled are:

- 1. Offset Printing & screen printing
- 2. Computer operating training
- 3. Stitching & Embroidery work
- 4. Carpentry
- 5. Computerized Braille Printing
